I will also be in consultation with Scott as well as TIPRO's staff regarding managing a smooth transition while carrying out normal business in furtherance of TIPRO's mission."

Haynes has been a staff member with TIPRO for five years serving first as the Director of Public Affairs and the past three years as EVP. "While I am excited about the next chapter in my life, I look back on my years of work with TIPRO and will miss the daily interaction with many of you. I will certainly miss the extended family that I have grown to know and count on. Fortunately for me, I will continue to be involved with TIPRO and serve as CHK's point of contact for the Association."

Mayfield assures TIPRO members, "I look upon this transition as an opportunity for TIPRO to help carry the Association to its next level in support of our mission statement and a furtherance of our goals. Looking back on this last Legislative Session, I realize more than ever the value of TIPRO in 'preserving the ability to explore and produce oil and natural gas.'
