## **ENERGY CITIZEN RALLY IN HOUSTON, TUESDAY, AUGUST 18**

The American Petroleum Institute (API) will kick off a series of "Energy Citizen Rallies" on Tuesday, August 18 at 11:30 am at the Verizon Wireless Theater, 520 Texas Ave., Houston, Texas, 77002.
